He is a member of the American Podiatric Medical Association, the Michigan Podiatric Medical Association, and the American Public Health Association.

Dr. Hughes serves on several boards and committees. He was President of the MPMA from 2012 - 2014 and served on the Board of Directors from 2007 - 2016. He also served on the Blue Cross Blue Shield Liaison Committee and was Chairman of the Legislative Committee from 1999 until he became president in 2012. Dr. Hughes was appointed by Governor Granholm to the Licensing Board for Podiatric Medicine and Surgery in 2007 and was re-appointed by Governor Snyder for 2012 - 2015. He has served on several committees for the APMA, and the 2017 House of Delegates he was elected to the American Podiatric Medical Association Board of Trustees.

Dr. Hughes lives with his wife Kari and their 5 children in Monroe, MI. He loves the outdoors and enjoys snowmobiling and river rafting with his sons.
